(details at <http://www.newyorknewyork.com/meetings/alternative-venues/brooklyn-bridge.aspx> with image gallery) which is a 10,000 square foot meeting space outside overlooking the strip and their property, which is obviously fairly unique. It can seat up to 600 for a dinner service.

From what I've heard in [this](#) thread on TK, it sounds like the bridge is more commonly used for the ceremony and then the reception is inside; probably since you wouldn't really want an outdoor reception in Vegas most times of the year. They charge a varying amount based on the number of guests. Information I've been given by two people in summer 2012 suggests the fee is \$650 for up to 30, \$800 to have a ceremony on the bridge with up to 40 guests and \$1000 for up to 60 guests. There is a 20% service charge added to any of those options. The ceremony fees include chairs, aisle runner and security to keep non-guests from wandering in.

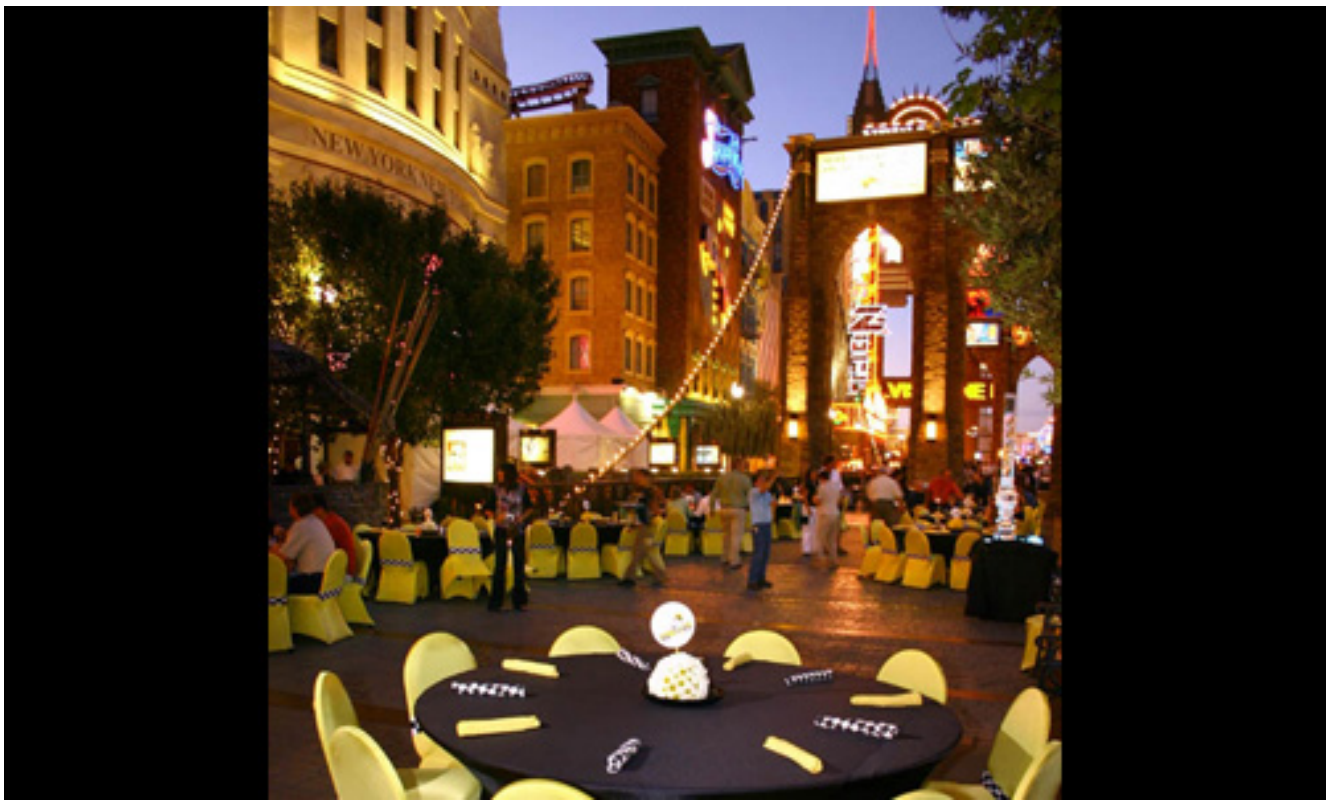
